



**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD
WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

***Awarding Bid for Purchase of LED Lighting and Fixtures for River Valley
Detention Center***

WHEREAS, in order to receive the most competitive price available for replacing T12 and T8 lighting with more efficient LED lighting fixtures at River Valley Detention Center, the County Executive's Office solicited proposals; and

WHEREAS, on July 18th, 2023, the Will County Executive's Office opened two (2) proposals for replacing T12 and T8 lighting with more efficient LED lighting at River Valley Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing such proposals, the recommendation from Resource, Recovery & Energy Division of the Land Use Department, is to award the bid for replacing T12 and T8 lighting with more efficient LED lighting fixtures to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder NC LED, De Pere, WI for a total amount of \$26,508.70, of which the County is expected to receive up to \$25,728 in ComEd rebates, pending review by the electric utility; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health & Public Safety Committee concurs with this recommendation.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the bid for replacing T12 and T8 lighting with more efficient LED lighting fixtures at River Valley Detention Facility to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder NC LED, De Pere, WI for a total amount of \$26,508.70, of which the County is expected to receive up to \$25,728 in ComEd rebates, pending review by the electric utility.

Adopted by the Will County Board this 17th day of August, 2023.



RE: Bid 2023-83 Recommendation

The River Valley Justice Center is replacing T12 and T8 lighting with more efficient LED lighting to improve performance and energy savings. Bid 2023-83 "Lighting Fixtures for River Valley Justice Center" solicited 2x2 fixtures and 2x4 fixtures for the administrative side of the building, as well as 4-foot lamps for the detention side of the building.

Both responses received by the close of the bidding window on July 18, 2023, included 2x2 and 2x4 fixtures that met the bid specifications, but neither response included 4-foot lamps that met the bid specifications. The Resource Recovery and Energy Division therefore recommends that the Will County Board authorize purchase of the 115 2x2 fixtures and 300 2x4 fixtures from NCLED, LLC. These lights cost \$26,508.70, which is a lower price than that for comparable lights in the competing bid response. These lights are also expected to receive up to \$25,728.00 in ComEd rebates, pending review by the electric utility.
