***Awarding Bid for Food Service at River Valley Juvenile Center***

WHEREAS, in order to receive the most competitive price available, the Will County Executive's Office solicited bids for food service for River Valley Juvenile Center, and

WHEREAS, after reviewing such proposals, the River Valley Juvenile Center Director, with approval from the Illinois State Board of Education, recommends the bid be awarded to Aramark Correctional Services, of Downers Grove, IL, for an approximate annual amount of \$177,408.003. This cost will fluctuate based upon population. This amount is based on an average daily population of forty-two (42) for three (3) meals and two (2) snacks per day. This contract will begin August 3, 2018 and continue through and including August 2, 2019, with two (2) additional one (1) year optional renewals, if the County so chooses, and

WHEREAS, the Judicial Committee concurs with this bid award and recommends approval to the full County Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the bid to Aramark Correctional Services, of Downers Grove, IL, for an approximate annual amount of \$177,408.003. This cost will fluctuate based upon population. This amount is based on an average daily population of forty-two (42), for three (3) meals and two (2) snacks per day. This contract will begin August 3, 2018 and continue through and including August 2, 2019, with two (2) additional one (1) year optional renewals, if the County so chooses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.






Re: Food Service Bid

The River Valley Detention Center is requesting to be placed on the appropriate Committee Agenda. The Detention Center's food service contract for three one-year renewals expires in August, 2018. As a result, the Detention Center sought invitations for Bid for a new contract beginning August 3, 2018. Revisions cannot be made to the executed *Invitation for Bid and Contract* without first submitting proposed revisions to the ISBE Nutrition Programs Division for review and receiving notification the proposed revisions are allowable. Furthermore, additional documents and/or agreements, including those developed by the contractor, cannot become part of the executed contract.

All procurement transactions must be conducted in compliance with the Conflict of Interest standards and requirements included in 2 CFR 200.112 and 2 CFR 200.318. All procurement transactions must be conducted in a manner providing full and open competition consistent with the standards of 2 CFR 200.319. In order to ensure objective contractor performance and eliminate unfair competitive advantage, contractors that developed or drafted specifications requirements, statements of work, or invitations for bids or requests for proposals must be excluded from competing for this procurement.

Following the contract award, you must submit the enclosed *Post-Contract Award Summary Sheet* along with all requested documentation noted on the form. The form is available online at [http://www.isbe.net/nutrition/htmls/contract\\_submission.htm](http://www.isbe.net/nutrition/htmls/contract_submission.htm) and is interactive. Ensure also the certification statement is signed by the school food authority's authorized representative.
