Awarding Bid for DOT Fuel Tank Replacement

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the most competitive rates for fuel tank replacement at three (3) DOT fueling locations, proposals were solicited, and

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2024, the County Executive's Office opened two (2) proposals for the fuel tank replacement project, and

WHEREAS, the DOT Maintenance Administration, has recommended to award the bid for fuel tank replacement at three (3) DOT fueling locations lowest responsible bidder, Stenstrom Petroleum Service Group, Rockford, IL for a base bid price of \$1,889,251.00, with a unit price per gallon for liquid removal of \$1.45, and a unit price per ton of soil removal of \$65.00, and

WHEREAS, one-half of the base bid which equals \$944,626.00, shall be funded from the County Board Capital Improvement/Repair Fund, and

WHEREAS, one-half of the base bid which equals \$944,626.00 plus the liquid removal at \$1.45/gallon and the soil removal at \$65.00/ton shall be made using the County RTA Tax Funds, and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee has concurred with this recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby awards the bid for fuel tank replacement at three (3) DOT fueling locations lowest responsible bidder, Stenstrom Petroleum Service Group, Rockford, IL for a base bid price of \$1,889,251.00, with a unit price per gallon for liquid removal of \$1.45, and a unit price per ton of soil removal of \$65.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Preamble of this Resolution is hereby adopted as if fully set forth herein. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
