This permit covers the operation and presence of specified equipment, material, or facility on the County right-of-way which may be related to the authorized work, and is subject to the conditions and restrictions printed on the reverse side of this sheet.

This permit allows the Applicant, his successors and assigns, occupancy and work on Will County right-of-way as outlined in the Will County DOT Permit and Access Control Regulations Ordinance.

This permit in no way grants permission, nor releases the Applicant from obtaining permission from the appropriate property owner and/or local authority, for any work outside the County right-of-way.

Contractors must have an executed copy of this permit at the job site for inspection by the County.

This permit is subject to the conditions and restrictions of the Will County DOT Permit and Access Control Regulations Ordinance, including but not limited to the following:

1. The Applicant represents all parties in interest and shall furnish all material, labor, pay all costs required, and shall in a reasonable length of time restore said highway to a condition similar or equal to the conditions that existed before the commencement of the described work. It shall be the responsibility of the Applicant to properly grade (positive drainage), seed, or sod any portions of the right-of-way disturbed during the described work, and follow proper Erosion and Sedimentation Control at all times. Note that the roadside ditch shall be graded to provide positive drainage at all times.
2. In granting this permit, the Applicant agrees to provide traffic control with warning signs and barricades conforming to the IDOT "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" (latest edition) or as specified; and to provide controlled flow of traffic at all times by detour or flagmen to minimize inconvenience to traffic. The work may be done during daylight hours on any day in accordance with Article 107.09 of the IDOT "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction." Furthermore, all construction shall be performed between May 1st and November 30th, unless otherwise approved in writing by the County Engineer. Traffic control shall follow the MUTCD and IDOT Standards for signing and flagging.
3. The work performed by the Applicant is for the bona fide purposes expressed and not for the purpose of, nor will it result in, the parking or servicing of vehicles on the highway right-of-way. Signs located on or overhanging the right-of-way shall be prohibited. Vertical headwalls, decorative signing, plantings, and trees are also prohibited inside the County right-of-way
4. WCDOT must be notified a minimum of 3 business days in advance of construction to locate WCDOT underground electrical facilities. 815-727-8476 highways@willcountyllinois.com
5. The proposed improvement shall be located and constructed to the satisfaction of the Will County Division of Transportation and the material used and method of construction shall conform with IDOT "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" (latest edition). No revisions or additions shall be made to the proposed work within the right-of-way without the written permission of the County Engineer.
6. The Applicant, his successors and assigns, shall assume all risk and shall agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the County for damages incurred to persons and property in conjunction with this work.
7. The petitioner shall install all road crossings without disturbing the existing surface or base of the roadway by augering unless written approval is granted by the county engineer to open cut the pavement. All boring, augering, or jacking pits shall be a minimum of ten feet (10') from the closest edge of pavement.
8. The Applicant shall not trim, cut, or in any way disturb any trees or shrubbery along the highway without the approval of the County Engineer or his duly authorized representative.
9. The County reserves the right to make changes, additions, repairs, and relocations within its statutory limits to the facilities constructed under this permit or their appurtenances on the right-of-way as may at any time be considered necessary to permit the relocation, reconstruction, widening, or maintaining of the highway and/or to provide proper protection to life and property on or adjacent to the County right-of-way. However, in the event this permit is granted to construct, locate, operate, and maintain facilities on the County right-of-way, the Applicant, upon written request by the County Engineer, shall perform such alterations or change of location of the facilities, without expense to the County, and should the Applicant fail to make satisfactory arrangements to comply with this request within a reasonable time, the County reserves the right to make such alterations or change of location or remove the work, and the Applicant shall pay for the cost incurred.
10. This permit is effective only insofar as the Will County Division of Transportation has jurisdiction and does not release the Applicant from complying with existing statutes or local regulations relating to the construction of such work. When crossing or working along any road other than a County road, the Applicant must consult with and obtain permission from the road authority upon or under whose road the work is being performed.
11. The petitioner affirms that the property lines and right-of-way lines shown on the attached sheet(s) are true and correct and binds and obligates himself to perform the operation in accordance with the description and attached sketch and to abide by the policy regulations. Construction staking of the new facilities shall be required prior to construction. The ROW shall be staked by the permit holder with dimensions tying the facility to the ROW. WCDOT is NOT responsible for confirming said ROW lines.
12. The Applicant shall notify the Will County Division of Transportation 48 hours prior to construction and at the completion of the work described.
